

ADVENT SERVICE OF LESSONS AND CAROLS SCHEDULED AT ST. THOMAS CHURCH MAMARONECK

Mamaroneck, NY. December 6, 2016.

An Advent Service of Lessons & Carols, comprised of music, readings and prayers, will be held at St. Thomas Episcopal Church on Sunday, December 18, at 4 p.m. It will be the first time in recent years that the church will offer this special service.

This particular program, in accordance with the Anglican tradition of King's College-Cambridge, is performed during the Advent season. The Rev. Carol D. Gadsden, Rector of St. Thomas, will preside. St. Thomas' choir will be joined in this performance by the choir of St. John's Lattingtown, under the baton of St. Thomas' Director of Music, Eric Milnes.

Carols and readings will include both ancient and contemporary, set in a festively decorated and candlelit 19th century architectural gem that offers crystalline acoustics

St. Thomas Church is located at 168 West Boston Post Road, at the corner of Mt. Pleasant Avenue, in Mamaroneck. There is ample parking space, and it is five blocks from the Metro North station.

St. Thomas welcomes all "seekers, searchers and doubter" to our diverse, open and affirming congregation. It offers worship services in English and Spanish, Christian education for children, Bible study groups, a Brown Bag lunch program, a Men's Group, concerts, a book group and other activities. It is the site of an after school child care program, winter Farmers' Market and an annual Christmas Fair that raises money for community non-profits.
